The FLA Disaster Relief Fund was established in September 2004 in memory of Founding Members Beth Palmer (former FLA Director, Vice President, and Secretary) and Jan Mitchell (wife of FLA President Al Mitchell), who went to the Rainbow Bridge in 2003. Monies in the fund were initiated using memorial donations made by friends and members of the Palmer and Mitchell families. Creation of the Fund was prompted by the destruction Florida wolfdog owners faced during the 2004 Hurricane Season. The goal of the Fund is to provide financial assistance to wolfdog owners who have suffered animal-related losses as a result of a disaster (*e.g.*, fire, hurricane, tornado, etc).

Applicants seeking financial assistance must be wolfdog owners and must supply original receipt(s) showing proof of wolfdog-related costs and/or work completed as a result of damage sustained during a disaster. Individuals will be given priority over businesses and organizations. To apply for financial assistance through the Fund, simply complete this form and mail it, along with the original receipt(s), to the FLA Secretary at the following address:
